**AND WHEREAS**, on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, the committee is satisfied that the institution fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the said teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratories etc., for running the programme and has appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to D.R.K. Reddy College of Physical Education, K.No. 426, 439, 440, 447, 448, 449, 532, Plot No. 7-266, 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Gollala Mamidada Village & Post, Pedapudi Mandal Taluk, East Godavari District-533344, Andhra Pradesh for conducting B.P.Ed Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2012-2013 under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009 subject, to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- I. The endowment fund of Rs.5 lakhs and reserve fund of Rs.3 lakhs kept in joint account with SRC, NCTE should be maintained always. Loan raising or mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
  - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
  - III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.
  - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
2. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.

5. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

**ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993(73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 1.12.2014.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution **D.R.K.Reddy College of Physical Education, K.No. 426, 439, 440, 447, 448, 449, 532, Plot No. 7-266, 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Gollala Mamidada Village & Post, Pedapudi Mandal Taluk, East Godavari District-533344, Andhra Pradesh** has by affidavit consented to come under New Regulations and sought for 100 intake in B.P.Ed.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, on scrutiny it is found that the institution has not maintained/revalidated the Fixed Deposited Receipts towards Endowment and Reserve Funds.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, it has been decided to permit the institution to have one basic unit of 100 students( two sections of 50 each) subject to the institution fulfilling following conditions namely,

- (i). The institution shall submit revalidated FDRs of the enhanced values, in joint account with the SRC before 30 June, 2015 failing which the recognition will be withdrawn.
- (ii). The institution shall appoint additional staff as per Regulations, 2014 and submit approved staff list to the Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
